The A1(M) Motorway (Junctions 2 - 4) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 Variation Order 2011

 Made
 4th April 2011

 Coming into force
 2nd May 2011

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) and (7) and 15(2) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a):-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junctions 2 4) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 Variation Order 2011 and shall come into force on 2nd May 2011.
- **2.** The A1(M) Motorway (Junctions 2 4) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009(**b**) is hereby varied by substituting -
 - (a) for the definition of "a first period" in article 2 of that Order, the following definition -
 - ""a first period" means a period of 24 hours starting at 0001 hours on Friday 1st May 2009 or on subsequent day until 2nd August 2011;"; and
 - (b) for the definition of "a second period" in article 2 of that Order, the following definition ""a second period" means a period of -
 - (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 4th May 2009 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
 - (ii) 8 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 1st May 2009 or on any subsequent Friday,
 - (iii) 9 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 2nd May 2009 or on any subsequent Saturday,
 - (iv) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 3rd May 2009 or on any subsequent Sunday,

until 2nd August 2011;".
