ROAD TRAFFIC

The A19 Trunk Road (Parkway Interchange to Crathorne Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *14th April 2011*

Coming into force - - *17th April 2011*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A19 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the Districts of Stockton and Middlesbrough, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because bridge repair works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A19 Trunk Road (Parkway Interchange to Crathorne Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 17th April 2011.

2. In this Order; -

“the A19” means the A19 Trunk Road;

“the southbound carriageway” means the A19 southbound carriageway between the nose of the southbound exit slip road at the A174 Parkway Interchange and the nose of the southbound entry slip road at the A67 Crathorne Interchange, a distance of approximately 7420 metres;

“a slip road” means any of the following A19 slip roads:

- (i) the southbound exit slip road at Crathorne Interchange; and
- (ii) the southbound entry slip road at Parkway Interchange;

“a layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the A19 over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“the works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 18th April 2011 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the southbound carriageway or a slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or wait in a layby situated adjacent to the A19 southbound carriageway between Parkway Interchange and Crathorne Interchange.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and nothing shall apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
