ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Motorway (Junctions 39-40 Northbound Carriageway) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011

 Made
 21st April 2011

 Coming into force
 8th May 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway is satisfied that traffic on a section of that motorway in the District of Eden in the County of Cumbria should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junctions 39-40 Northbound Carriageway) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 8th May 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M6 Motorway between Junctions 39 and 40;

"the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road" means the last point where the slip road leaves the carriageway of the motorway;

"the length of carriageway" means a section of the northbound carriageway of the motorway from a point 3200 metres south of the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 40 to a point 1525 metres south of the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 40;

"the works period" means a period starting at 0900 hours on Monday 9 May 2011 and ending at 1600 hours on Friday 20 May 2011. However, works may start and continue beyond these dates until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work.

"works" means safety barrier works on the motorway.

3.Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven in the length of carriageway at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour.

- **4.** The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
- **5.** No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
