The A27 Trunk Road (Falmer House Road) (No Entry) Order 2011

 Coming into force
 9th May 2011

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Falmer House Road) (No Entry) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 9th May 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A27 Trunk Road (Lewes Road/Falmer Hill) at Falmer in the City of Brighton & Hove and the County of East Sussex between the A270 (Lewes Road) and Falmer Interchange (B2123).

- **3.** Save as provided in article 4 below, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter Falmer House Road from its junction with the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road to the highway boundary, a total distance of 6.5 metres.
 - **4.** Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes; or
 - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
