**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Cholmondeley
Castle) Regulations 2011**

Made - - - - *4th May 2011*

Coming into force - - *15th July 2011*

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Cholmondeley Castle, Cheshire by reason of the holding of a flying display that is scheduled to take place in the period from 15th to 17th July 2011.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Cholmondeley Castle) Regulations 2011 and come into force on 15th July 2011.

2. In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2)—

- (a) between 1100 hours and 1800 hours on 15th July 2011,
- (b) between 0700 hours and 2200 hours on 16th July 2011, and
- (c) between 0700 hours and 1800 hours on 17th July 2011,

no aircraft is to fly below 2,500 feet above mean sea level within the area of a circle having a radius of 2.5 nautical miles whose centre is at 530323N 0024048W.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying in accordance with the permission of the Cholmondeley Castle flying display director.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Cholmondeley Castle Cheshire on the occasion of the Pageant of Power Airshow to be held there between 15th and 17th July 2011. A large number of civil and military aircraft will be involved in high energy manoeuvres during the event. The Civil Aviation Authority's Directorate of Airspace Policy (DAP) considers that Restrictions of Flying should be established in the vicinity of Cholmondeley Castle for reasons of public safety and this has been agreed with the Department for Transport..

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
