ROAD TRAFFIC

The A38 and A5148 Trunk Roads (A38 Weeford to Swinfen, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 3rd May 2011

Coming into force - - 10th May 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”), the A5148 Trunk Road (“the A5148”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of the A38 and on four of those connecting roads, south of Lichfield in the County of Staffordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 and A5148 Trunk Roads (A38 Weeford to Swinfen, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 10th May 2011.

2. In this Order:

“Swinfen Roundabout”	means the circulatory carriageway of the A38/A5148/A5206 roundabout junction;
“Weeford Roundabout”	means the circulatory carriageway of the A38/M6 Toll/A5/B5404 roundabout junction;
“the trunk road”	means the northbound carriageway of the A38 from its junction with the slip road leading to Weeford Roundabout to its junction with Swinfen Roundabout;
“a slip road”	means any slip road leading to or from Swinfen Roundabout;
“the works period”	means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 16th May 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on Swinfen Roundabout, the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
