ROAD TRAFFIC

The M62 Motorway (Junction 22 and Junction 24) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

 Made - - - - - 12th May 2011

 Coming into force - - 22nd May 2011

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M62 Motorway and connecting roads, in the Districts of Calderdale and Kirklees, in the County of West Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing and general maintenance works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the M62 Motorway (Junction 22 and Junction 24) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 22nd May 2011.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 9 hours commencing at 21:00 hours on Monday 23rd May 2011 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the M62 Motorway:
 - (i) eastbound entry slip road at Junction 22 (Rishworth Moor); or
 - (ii) westbound entry slip road at Junction 24 (Ainley Top);
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
 - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform.
