The A1(M) Motorway (Letchworth Road Bridge, Hertfordshire) Northbound (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway ("the A1(M)") is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Hertfordshire should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(2)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Letchworth Road Bridge, Hertfordshire) Northbound (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 27 January 2011.
- 2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during the period starting at 14.00 hours on Thursday 27 January 2011 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this Order, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the northbound carriageway of the A1(M) between points 650 metres south and 175 metres north of the centre point of the Letchworth Road bridge road.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes.
