## ROAD TRAFFIC

The A43 Trunk Road (Evenley Roundabout, South of Brackley, Northamptonshire) (Derestriction) Order 2011

 Made
 17th May 2011

 Coming into force
 31st May 2011

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred by section 82(2) and 83(1) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A43 Trunk Road (Evenley Roundabout, South of Brackley, Northamptonshire) (Derestriction) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 31st May 2011.
- 2. The length of the A43 Trunk Road, south of Brackley, in the County of Northamptonshire, between points 61 metres southwest and 61 metres northeast of its roundabout junction with Broad Lane, known as Evenley Roundabout, including the circulatory carriageway of that roundabout, shall cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- **3.** Any previous order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replaced by that Act which provided that the trunk road or any part thereof should cease to be a restricted road is amended by excluding any reference to the lengths of trunk road described in article 2 of this order.
