ROAD TRAFFIC

The M1 Motorway (Junction 29a) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011

Made - - - - *31st May 2011*
Coming into force - *7th June 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway (“the M1”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway in the County of Derbyshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junction 29a) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 7th June 2011.

2. In this Order:

”the motorway” means the southbound carriageway of the M1 between a point 3000 metres north and a point 1000 metres south of the centreline of the A632 Chesterfield Road overbridge (south of Junction 29a);

“the works period” means the period starting at 2300 hours on Tuesday 14th June 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
