**The A46 Trunk Road (Birchwood, Lincolnshire) (Temporary
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - - *20th May 2011*
Coming into force - - - - - *27th May 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, near Birchwood in the County of Lincolnshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Birchwood, Lincolnshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 27th May 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the A46 from a point 808 metres south of its southern junction with Whisby Road to a point 849 metres north of its roundabout junction with the B1190 (Lincoln Road/Doddington Road);

“overall width” has the meaning given in regulation 3(2) of the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986(b);

“the works period” means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Wednesday 1st June 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 8 and 9, no person shall, during the works period, drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 8 and 9, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 8 and 9, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle which has an overall width exceeding 3.5 metres to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

- 6.** Subject as mentioned in articles 8 and 9, no person shall, during the works period –
- (a) cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in –
 - (i) the northbound carriageway of the trunk road; or
 - (ii) the offside lane of the southbound carriageway of trunk road in any direction other than northwards; and
 - (b) cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in –
 - (i) the southbound carriageway of the trunk road; or
 - (ii) the offside lane of the northbound carriageway of trunk road in any direction other than southwards.

7. Subject as mentioned in articles 8 and 9, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to make a right turn into or out of the northbound or southbound carriageways of the trunk road at its junction with Whisby Road.

8. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

9. The provisions of:

- (a) articles 3, 4, 5, 6 (a)(i), 6(b)(i) and 7 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
- (b) articles 4, 5, 6(a)(i), 6(b)(i) and 7 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
