## ROAD TRAFFIC

# The A45 Trunk Road (Wellingborough, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

 Made
 7th June 2011

 Coming into force
 14th June 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road ("the A45"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Wellingborough in the County of Northamptonshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Wellingborough, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 14th June 2011.

### 2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the eastbound carriageway of the A45 between its

junction with the slip road leading to the A509 and B573 Turnells Mill Lane (Junction 14) roundabout and its junction with the slip road leading from that roundabout;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20.30 hours on Tuesday 21st

June 2011 and ending when the said works have been

completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
  - **5.** The provisions of articles 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
