The Portsmouth Road, Hindhead, Surrey (Restricted Road) Order 2011

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 82(2) and 83(1) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), having consulted with the chief officer of Surrey Police, makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into force on 10th July 2011, and may be cited as the Portsmouth Road, Hindhead, Surrey (Restricted Road) Order 2011.
- 2. The length of the A3 Trunk Road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be a restricted road for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- **3.** The Trunk Roads (40 mph Speed Limit) (No 15) Order 1976(**b**) is hereby revoked.

THE SCHEDULE

Length of road to be a restricted road

The Portsmouth Road at Hindhead in the Borough of Waverley in the County of Surrey, from a point in Portsmouth Road 35 metres east of its junction with Footpath 103B to a point in Portsmouth Road 30 metres south west of the centre of the access to Tyndalls Wood, a total distance of approximately 840 metres (all distances are measured along that length of road).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This order revokes the existing 40mph speed limit on the A3 between the National Trust Car Park and the B3002 Headley Road in Hindhead and reclassifies this length of A3 as a restricted road and therefore subject to a 30mph speed limit.
