ROAD TRAFFIC

The A3(M) Motorway (Junction 4, Northbound Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3(M) Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed near the road:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3(M) Motorway (Junction 4, Northbound Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 16th July 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the A3(M) Motorway near Havant in the County of Hampshire;

"the slip road" means the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 4 (Purbrook Way);

"works" mean resurfacing work on the Purbrook Way roundabouts; and

"a works period" means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 18th July 2011 or on any subsequent day until 15th January 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
