ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Bridgtown, Staffordshire) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Bridgtown, Cannock in the County of Staffordshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Bridgtown, Staffordshire) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 11th July 2011.

2. In this Order –

"the trunk road"	means the eastbound carriageway of the A5 from its roundabout junction with the A4601 (Longford Roundabout) to its junction with North Street, Bridgtown;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 18th July 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on lengths of the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on those lengths of road are displayed.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for special forces, police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
