ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A30 Trunk Road (Tolvaddon Junction, Pool, Redruth)
(Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - - *13th July 2011*

Coming into force - - - - - *16th July 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road (“the A30”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads near Redruth in Cornwall should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Tolvaddon Junction, Pool, Redruth) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 16th July 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the slip road” means the westbound exit slip road at the A30 Tolvaddon Junction including (i) the northern spur of that slip road; and (ii) the southern spur of that slip road to a point 132 metres from its junction with the A3047 Tolvaddon Road;

“the northern spur” means the northern spur of the westbound exit slip road at the A30 Tolvaddon Junction;

“the works” mean junction improvement works;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 18th July 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period:

- (a) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the slip road;
- (b) cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the northern spur.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

5. The provisions of article 3(b) shall not apply to a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works or for traffic officer purposes.

6. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
