**The M61 Motorway (Junction 5 Northbound Exit Slip Road)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - - *13th July 2011*
Coming into force - - - - - *29th July 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M61 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the District of Bolton in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M61 Motorway (Junction 5 Northbound Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 29th July 2011.

2. In this Order;

“motorway” means the M61 Motorway;

“works” means utility works;

“the works period” means periods daily between 0800 hours and 1800 hours starting on Saturday 30 July 2011 and ending on Sunday 31 July 2011.

However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent days or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 5.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle leaving the motorway via the slip road to make any manoeuvre other than to turn left onto the A58 westbound.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
