**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A34 Trunk Road (Botley Interchange) (Closure of Lay-by)  
Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - - *24th January 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - - - - *7th February 2011*

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A34 Trunk Road (Botley Interchange) (Closure of Lay-by) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 7th February 2011.

**2.** In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A34 Trunk Road north of Botley Interchange in the County of Oxfordshire; and

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b).

**3.** No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter onto, or wait or stop in the lay-by in the northbound carriageway of the trunk road between points 653 metres and 723 metres north of the northern overbridge at Botley Interchange (A420).
