The M54 Motorway and the A5 Trunk Road (Cluddley to Preston, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No. 2)
Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M54 Motorway ("the M54"), the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those roads and one of those connecting roads, between Cluddley and Preston in the County of Shropshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M54 Motorway and the A5 Trunk Road (Cluddley to Preston, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No. 2) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 11th July 2011.

2. In this Order –

"the motorway" means the westbound carriageway of the M54 from its

junction with the exit slip road at Junction 7 to its junction

with the A5;

"the trunk road" means the westbound carriageway of the A5 from its

junction with the M54 at Junction 7 to its roundabout

junction with the A49 known as Preston Roundabout;

"the slip road" means the slip road leading to the westbound carriageway

of the A5 at M54 Junction 7;

"the works period" means the period starting at 21.30 hours on Monday 18th

July 2011 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway, the trunk road or the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
 - (c) being used for or in connection with the said works.
