The A52 Trunk Road (Spondon to M1 Junction 25, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road ("the A52") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and some of those connecting roads, in the County of Derbyshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road (Spondon to M1 Junction 25, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 18th July 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road"	 means – (i) the eastbound carriageway of the A52 from its junction with the slip road leading to the A5111, at Spondon to its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the M1 at Junction 25; and 	
	 (ii) the westbound carriageway of the A52 from its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the M1 at Junction 25 to its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A6005 at Spondon; 	
"a slip road"	 means the slip road leading - (i) to the westbound carriageway of the A52 from its roundabout junction with the M1 at Junction 25; (ii) from the westbound carriageway of the A52 at its junction with Victoria Avenue;

	(iii)	to the westbound carriageway of the A52 at its junction with Victoria Avenue;
	(iv)	to the eastbound carriageway of the A52 from its roundabout junction with the A6005;
	(v)	from the eastbound carriageway of the A52 at its junction with the A6096 Lodge Lane North;
	(vi)	from the eastbound carriageway of the A52 at its junction with Stoney Lane;
	(vii)	to the eastbound carriageway of the A52 at its junction with Stoney Lane;
	(viii)	from the eastbound carriageway of the A52 at its junction with Victoria Avenue;
	(ix)	to the eastbound carriageway of the A52 at its junction with Victoria Avenue; and
	(x)	from the eastbound carriageway of the A52 to its roundabout junction with the M1 at Junction 25;
"the link road"	carriag	the link road leading from the northbound eway of the A5111 to the eastbound carriageway A52 at Spondon;
"layby"	means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (a) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;	
"the works period"		the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 25th 011 and ending when the said works have been eted,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road, a slip road or the link road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any layby adjacent to the trunk road.

5. Subject as mentioned in article 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave –

(a) the eastbound carriageway of the A52 at its junction with -

- (i) the Filling Station access roads situated 350 metres west of Victoria Avenue;
- (ii) Cole Lane; and
- (iii) Manor Farm access road;

- (b) the westbound carriageway of the A52 at its junction with -
 - (i) Manor Farm access road;
 - (ii) Cole Lane; and
 - (iii) Borrowash Road.
- **6.** The provisions of articles 3, 4, and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 7. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle-
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform, or
 - (iii) being used in connection with the said works;

and article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
