## ROAD TRAFFIC

The M5 Motorway (Junction 29) and A30 Trunk Road (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011

 Made
 20th July 2011

 Coming into force
 23rd July 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway ("the M5") and the A30 Trunk Road ("the A30") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of the A30 and one of those connecting roads near Exeter in the County of Devon should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junction 29) and A30 Trunk Road (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 23rd July 2011.
  - 2. In this Order –

"the slip road" means the southbound exit slip road at M5 Junction 29;

"the works" mean carriageway widening, realignment and works on the central reserve;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 25th July 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period:
  - (a) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the slip road;
  - (b) cause or permit any vehicle to turn right from the A30 westbound carriageway to the northbound entry slip road at M5 Junction 29.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.
- **5**. The provisions of article 3(b) shall not apply to a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works or for traffic officer purposes.
