ROAD TRAFFIC

The A3 Trunk Road (Surrey, Cycle Race – Esher Common Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

 Made
 25th July 2011

 Coming into force
 14th August 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16A(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3 Trunk Road (Surrey, Cycle Race – Esher Common Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 14th August 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A3 Trunk Road in the County of Surrey;

"a slip road" means –

- (i) the road leading from the Londonbound carriageway of the trunk road to the A244 at Esher Common junction, or
- (ii) the road leading from the coastbound carriageway of the trunk road to the A244 at Esher Common junction;

"event" means the London Surrey Cycle Classic Road Race; and

"an event period" means a period of 9 hours starting at 0530 hours on Sunday 14th August 2011.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during an event period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to
 - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said event;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
 - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform:

- (d) a vehicle being used for the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency; or
- (e) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
