## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A27 Trunk Road (Beddingham Roundabout - Polegate) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

 Made
 1st August 2011

 Coming into force
 20th August 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on lengths of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Beddingham Roundabout - Polegate) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 20th August 2011.

## **2.** In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A27 Trunk Road in the County of East Sussex;

"the length of trunk road" means both carriageways of the trunk road between Beddingham roundabout (A26) and its junction with the A2270/Polegate By-pass at Polegate;

"lay-by" means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of the carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(**b**);

"an A27 lay-by" means -

- (i) the lay-bys adjacent to the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road 136 metres and 742 metres west of its junction with the A2270/Polegate By-pass at Polegate, or
- (ii) the lay-bys adjacent to the westbound carriageway of the trunk road 331 metres and 992 metres west of its junction with the A2270/Polegate By-pass at Polegate;

"works" means resurfacing, catseye and white lining work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 22nd August 2011 or on any subsequent day until 19th February 2013.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle -
  - (a) to enter or proceed in the length of trunk road; or

- (b) to enter or proceed in, or wait on, an A27 lay-by.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
  - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
  - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
  - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform:
  - (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
  - (e) a vehicle proceeding in the length of trunk road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that road to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
