ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1(M) Motorway (Junctions 6 to 7, Hertfordshire) Northbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

 Made
 8th August 2011

 Coming into force
 15th August 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway ("the A1(M)") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway and on one of those connecting roads in the County of Hertfordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junctions 6 to 7, Hertfordshire) Northbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 15th August 2011.

2. In this Order -

"tip of the nosing" means, as indicated by the markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip road joins, or the last point where an exit slip road leaves, the carriageway of the motorway;

"the motorway" means the northbound carriageway of the A1(M) from the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 6 to the centre point of the A602 north overbridge at Junction 7;

"the slip road" means the northbound entry slip road at Junction 6;

"works" mean resurfacing, repairs and renewal of road markings to the carriageway of the motorway and safety barrier maintenance;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 22nd August 2011 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (a) being used for, or in connection with, the works or for traffic officer purposes,

- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
