ROAD TRAFFIC

The A26 Trunk Road (Southease Railway Station – Tarring Neville) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made -	-	-	-	15th August 2011
Coming into	force	-	-	3rd September 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A26 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on lengths of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A26 Trunk Road (Southease Railway Station – Tarring Neville) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 3rd September 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A26 Trunk Road in the County of East Sussex;

"lay-by" means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(**b**);

"the length of trunk road" means both carriageways of the trunk road between points 50 metres south of its junction with the access to Southease Railway Station and a point 307 metres north of The Hollow, southeast of Tarring Neville;

"an A26 lay-by" means –

- (i) the lay-by in the northbound carriageway of the trunk road at Southease Railway Station,
- (ii) the lay-by in the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Southease Railway Station, or
- (iii) the lay-by in the southbound carriageway of the trunk road 400 metres north of The Hollow;

"works" mean carriageway repairs and associated work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 9½ hours starting at 1930 hours on Monday 5th September 2011 or on any subsequent day until 2nd March 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle -

- (a) to enter or proceed in, or wait on, an A26 lay-by; or
- (b) to enter or proceed in the length of trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
