**The A46 Trunk Road (Evesham Bypass, Worcestershire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *16th August 2011*
Coming into force - - *23rd August 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, near Evesham in the County of Worcestershire should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A46 Trunk Road (Evesham Bypass, Worcestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 23rd August 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A46 from its roundabout junction with the A4035 Badsey Road to its roundabout junction with the A44 Broadway Road;

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the period starting at 05.00 hours on Tuesday 30th August 2011 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this Order, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or the layby adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
