ROAD TRAFFIC

The A26 Trunk Road (New Road, Newhaven) (Waiting Restrictions) Order 2011

Made - - - 22nd August 2011

Coming into force - - 12th September 2011

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and 4(2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A26 Trunk Road (New Road, Newhaven) (Waiting Restrictions) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 12th September 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A26 Trunk Road at Newhaven in the County of East Sussex, comprising New Road;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000(**b**);

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000(c);

"parking disc" means a disc issued by a local authority, 125 millimetres square and coloured blue, if issued on or after 1st April 2000 or orange, if issued before that date, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting began; and

"relevant position" has the meaning given in regulation 4 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000.

- **3.** Save as provided in article 4 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable, a traffic warden or a traffic officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the length of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
 - **4.** (1) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle;
 - (b) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from a vehicle;

- (c) to render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait on the side of the trunk road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable that vehicle to be used in connection with -
 - (i) any building operation or demolition,
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic,
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the trunk road, or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal in or near the trunk road of any sewer, main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984(a); or
- (d) in relation to a vehicle being used -
 - (i) for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes,
 - (ii) in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties,
 - (iii) in the service of a water or sewage undertaker within the meaning of the Water Industry Act 1991(b), or
 - (iv) by a universal service provider for the purpose of providing a universal postal service as defined by the Postal Service Act 2000(c).
- (2) Nothing in article 3 above shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle, which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (upon which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began), to wait on the side of the trunk road referred to therein for a period not exceeding two hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by that vehicle on that length of road on the same day).

Article 3

THE SCHEDULE

Length of the trunk road on which waiting is prohibited at all times

The eastern side of the trunk road (New Road) from a point 188 metres north of its junction with Drove Road northwards to a point 220 metres north of its junction with Drove Road, a total distance of 32 metres.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order imposes waiting restrictions on a specified length of the A26 New Road, at Newhaven in the County of East Sussex as described in the Schedule. This extends the waiting restrictions imposed by The East Sussex (Roads at Newhaven) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1977.
