The M42 Motorway (Junction 3) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

 Made
 23rd August 2011

 Coming into force
 30th August 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway ("the M42"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway at Junction 3 in the County of Worcestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The M42 Motorway (Junction 3) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 30th August 2011.

2. In this Order -

"the motorway" means the eastbound carriageway of the M42 between its

junction with the exit slip road and its junction with the

entry slip road at Junction 3;

"the works period" means the period starting at 22.00 hours on Monday 5th

September 2011 and ending when the said works have

been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
