## ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1 Trunk Road (Eaton Ford, St Neots, Cambridgeshire) Southbound Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 5th September 2011

Coming into force - - 12th September 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road ("the A1") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Eaton Ford, St Neots, Cambridgeshire) Southbound Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 12th September 2011.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 08:00 hours on Monday 19th September 2011, or on any subsequent day until local authority works to a nearby roundabout and carriageway repairs have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A1 southbound exit slip road to and entry slip road from the B645 Great North Road Roundabout, Eaton Ford.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.
