ROAD TRAFFIC

The A30 Trunk Road (Daisymount Junction, Near Ottery St Mary, Devon) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 6th September 2011

Coming into force - - 13th September 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road ("the A30") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads in the County of Devon should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public during the Tour of Britain Cycle Race through the junction.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Daisymount Junction, Near Ottery St Mary, Devon) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 13th September 2011.

2. In this Order -

"the slip roads" mean the eastbound and westbound exit slip roads of the A30 at Daisymount Junction, near Ottery St Mary

"the period of danger" means the period starting at 14.00 hours on Thursday 15 September 2011 and ending when the period of danger to the public is over.

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the period of danger, cause any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip roads.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes or proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.
