ROAD TRAFFIC

The A38 Trunk Road (Lower Dean and Kennford, Devon) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 7th September 2011

Coming into force - - 10th September 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road ("the A38"), is satisfied that traffic on a connecting road near Buckfast in the Districts of South Hams and Teignbridge in the County of Devon and a connecting road near Kennford in the District of Teignbridge in the County of Devon should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Lower Dean and Kennford, Devon) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 10th September 2011.

2. In this Order –

"the first slip road" means the eastbound exit slip road of the A38 at Lower Dean; and

"the second slip road" means the eastbound entry slip road of the A38 at Kennford;

"the works" mean resurfacing and maintenance works;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 12th September 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- 3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4, no person shall, during a works period cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the first slip road or the second slip road of the A38;
 - 4 The provisions of articles 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, Traffic Officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or Traffic Officer in uniform.
