ROAD TRAFFIC

The A35 Trunk Road (Charmouth Bypass, Dorset) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *13th September 2011*

Coming into force - - *16th September 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A35 Trunk Road (“the A35”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Charmouth in the District of West Dorset in the County of Dorset should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A35 Trunk Road (Charmouth Bypass, Dorset) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 16th September 2011.

2. In this Order –

“A35” means the A35 from a point 40 metres west of the centre of its junction with Berne Lane, Charmouth, to the eastern edge of the A3052 Charmouth Roundabout;

“the works” mean carriageway repairs, resurfacing and maintenance works;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 19th September 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 19th September 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 8, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the A35 whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that road are displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the A35.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the westbound carriageway of the A35.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of a constable.

7. The provisions of article 5 shall not apply to a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for traffic officer purposes.

8. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
