**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A259 Trunk Road (Bexhill) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - - *19th September 2011*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *8th October 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road and prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Bexhill) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 8th October 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A259 Trunk Road at Bexhill in the County of East Sussex;

“the length of trunk road” means both carriageways of the trunk road between a point 200 metres west of its junction with Sutherland Avenue (B2098) and its junction with Bexleigh Avenue at Glyne Gap;

“West Down Road” means the road known as West Down Road at its junction with the trunk road;

“Down Road” means the road known as Down Road at its junction with the trunk road;

“Chandler Road” means the road known as Chandler Road at its junction with the trunk road;

“Eastwood Road” means the road known as Eastwood Road at its junction with the trunk road;

“Lewis Avenue” means the road known as Lewis Avenue at its junction with the trunk road at Glyne Gap roundabout;

“Hastings Road” means the road known as Hastings Road (A2036) at its junction with the trunk road at Glyne Gap roundabout;

“Ravenside Park” means the access road to and from Ravenside Park at its junction with the trunk road at Glyne Gap roundabout;

“works” mean resurfacing work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 10th October 2011 or on any subsequent day until 7th April 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter the trunk road from West Down Road, Down Road, Chandler Road, Eastwood Road, Lewis Avenue, Hastings Road or Ravenside Park or to enter West Down Road, Down Road, Chandler Road, Eastwood Road, Lewis Avenue, Hastings Road or Ravenside Park from the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. (1) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to –

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.

(2) Nothing in article 4 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
