## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A30 Trunk Road (Exeter Airport to Daisymount Junction, Devon) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 26th September 2011

Coming into force - - 30th September 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road ("the A30") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on that road and a connecting road in the District of East Devon in the County of Devon should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Exeter Airport to Daisymount Junction, Devon) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 30th September 2011.

## 2. In this Order -

"the A30" means the eastbound carriageway of the A30 Trunk Road from its junction with the C832 at Sowton to the tip of the nosing of the eastbound entry slip road at Daisymount Junction (B3180);

"the slip road" means the A30 eastbound entry slip road at the Clyst Honiton / Exeter Airport Junction (B3184);

"tip of the nosing" means the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of a trunk road or the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean concrete carriageway repair works;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 3rd October 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed.

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A30 or the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes; (b) a vehicle being used for or in
