ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A30 Trunk Road (Carland Cross to Chiverton Cross,
Cornwall) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *3rd October 2011*

Coming into force - - *8th October 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road (“the A30”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road between the Carland Cross Roundabout and the Chiverton Cross Roundabout near Newquay in Cornwall should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Carland Cross to Chiverton Cross, Cornwall) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 8th October 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the first length of the A30” means both carriageways of the A30 near Newquay from the western edge of Carland Cross Roundabout to the eastern edge of Chiverton Cross Roundabout;

“the second length of the A30” means both carriageways of the A30 near Newquay from the western edge of the B3285 Box Heater Junction to the eastern edge of Chiverton Cross Roundabout;

“the works” mean resurfacing and other maintenance works including drainage works, sign washing, road stud installation, white lining and grass cutting;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 10th October 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first length of the A30 or the second length of the A30.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
