## CIVIL AVIATION

The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Sculthorpe Airfield) (Revocation) Regulations 2011

Made - - - - 6th October 2011

Coming into force - - 7th October 2011

The Secretary of State has deemed it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Sculthorpe Airfield, Norfolk by reason of the intended operation of an unlit, unmarked tethered balloon which was scheduled to take place in the period from 8th to 23rd October 2011.

The said operation having been postponed, the Secretary of State no longer deems it necessary to restrict flying in the vicinity of Sculthorpe Airfield and makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

- **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Sculthorpe Airfield) (Revocation) Regulations 2011 and come into force on 7th October 2011.
- **2.** The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Sculthorpe Airfield) Regulations 2011(**b**) are revoked.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations revoke the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) Regulations (Sculthorpe Airfield) Regulations 2011 (S.I. 2011/2104) which imposed restrictions of flying in airspace in the vicinity of Sculthorpe Airfield, Norfolk in the period from 8th to 23rd October 2011, the operation which required the restrictions having been postponed.
