ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M5 Motorway (Junction 9) and the A46 Trunk Road
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *3rd October 2011*
Coming into force - - *10th October 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway (“the M5”), the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on five of those connecting roads near Tewkesbury in the County of Gloucestershire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junction 9) and the A46 Trunk Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 10th October 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway at the roundabout junction of the M5 (Junction 9), A46 and A438;

“a slip road” means –
i) any slip road leading to or from the northbound and southbound carriageways of the M5 at Junction 9;
ii) the slip road leading from the westbound carriageway of the A46 to the roundabout;

“the works period” means the period starting at 21.00 hours on Monday 17th October 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter the roundabout from the A438 Ashchurch Road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
