**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M42 and M6 Motorways (M42 Junction 8) (Link Road)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *3rd October 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - *10th October 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway (“the M42”), the M6 Motorway (“the M6”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Warwickshire and the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M42 and M6 Motorways (M42 Junction 8) (Link Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 10th October 2011.

2. In this Order:

| “the link road”    | means the link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 8 to the northbound carriageway of the M6; |
| “the works period” | means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Thursday 13th October 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;    |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform, or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
