ROAD TRAFFIC

The A66 Trunk Road (Lightwater Culvert, Penrith) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A66 Trunk Road is satisfied that traffic on sections of that trunk road in the District of Eden in the County of Cumbria should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A66 Trunk Road (Lightwater Culvert, Penrith) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 30th October 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A66 Trunk Road;

"the first length of carriageway" means the eastbound dual carriageway section and single carriageway section of the trunk road from a point 2.3 kilometres west of the centreline of the Lightwater Culvert to a point 0.7 kilometres east of the same point;

"the second length of carriageway" means westbound carriageway of the trunk road from the start of the dual carriageway (at the eastern end) to a point 0.7 kilometres west of the centreline of the Lightwater Culvert;

"the works period" means periods daily between 1000 hours and 1500 hours during a period starting on Monday 31 October 2011 and ending on Saturday 19 November 2011. However, works may start and continue between the same times on subsequent days or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"works" means maintenance works on the trunk road.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven in the first or second length of carriageway at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.

5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations $2011(\mathbf{a})$ when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
