## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The M58 Motorway (Orrell Interchange) (Link Road between the Eastern Roundabout and the A577 Orrell Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M58 Motorway and its link roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those link roads in the District of Wigan in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order.

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M58 Motorway (Orrell Interchange) (Link Road between the Eastern Roundabout and the A577 Orrell Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 6th November 2011.

2. In this Order;

"motorway" means the M58 Motorway;

"works" means drainage survey works on the link road;

"the works period" means a period over five nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours starting on Monday 7 November 2011 and ending on Saturday 12 November 2011.

However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the link road" means the link road between the eastern roundabout of the motorway and the A577 Orrell Road at Orrell Interchange;

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road.
- 4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
