ROAD TRAFFIC

The A23 Trunk Road and the A27 Trunk Road (Patcham Interchange, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No. 2) Order 2011

Made - - - - 24th October 2011

Coming into force - - 12th November 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A23 Trunk Road, the A27 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A23 Trunk Road and the A27 Trunk Road (Patcham Interchange, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No. 2) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 12th November 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the A23" and "the A27" mean, respectively, the A23 Trunk Road and the A27 Trunk Road in the City of Brighton and Hove;

"a slip road" means -

- (i) the road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the A27 to the northbound carriageway of the A23 at Patcham Interchange, or
- (ii) the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A23 to the link road leading to the A27 at Patcham Interchange;

"works" mean street lighting replacement work on the A23 and the A27; and

"a works period" means a period of 12 hours starting at 1900 hours on Monday 14th November 2011 or on any subsequent day until 11th May 2013.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
 - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
