ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1 Trunk Road (Near Stamford) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 24th January 2011

Coming into force - - 31st January 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road ("the A1) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those connecting roads, in the District of the County of Rutland, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Near Stamford) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 31 January 2011.

2. In this Order:

"a slip road" means the slip roads leading to –

- (a) the northbound carriageway of the A1 from
 - (i) the A606 Empingham Road; and
 - (ii) the A6121 Tinwell Road; and
- (b) the southbound carriageway of the A1 from
 - (i) the A606 Empingham Road; and
 - (ii) the A6121 Tinwell Road;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 2100 hours on Monday 7 February 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –
(a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
(c) being used in connection with the said works.
