**The A46 Trunk Road (Wanlip to Cossington, Leicestershire)
(Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *31st October 2011*
Coming into force - - *7th November 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and some of those connecting roads, between Wanlip and Cossington in the County of Leicestershire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Wanlip to Cossington, Leicestershire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 7th November 2011.

2. In this Order:

- “the first length of trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A46 from a point 1000 metres southwest of its junction with the exit slip road leading to its roundabout junction the A6 (Wanlip Roundabout), to its junction with the slip road;
- “the second length of trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to the A6 (Wanlip Roundabout), to its roundabout junction with the A607 (Hobby Horse Roundabout);
- “the third length of trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A46 from its roundabout junction with the A607 (Hobby Horse Roundabout) to a point 415 metres north of its junction with the exit slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A607/Syston Road;
- “the first length of slip road” means the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the A46 to its roundabout junction with the A6 (Wanlip Roundabout);

“the second length of slip road”	means the slip road leading – i) to the northbound carriageway of the A46 from its roundabout junction with the A6 (Wanlip Roundabout); and ii) to the northbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with Fillingate;
“the link road”	means the link road leading directly from the northbound carriageway of the A46 to the northbound carriageway of the A46 at Hobby Horse Roundabout;
“the works period”	means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 14th November 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road or the first length of slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of trunk road, the third length of trunk road, the second length of slip road or the link road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the northbound carriageway of the A46 at its junction with the Quarry access roads situated 545 metres west of Hobby Horse Roundabout;

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4, and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of:

- (a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;
- (b) articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle –
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (c) articles 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works; and
- (d) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
