ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Cross in Hand Roundabout, Lutterworth) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 1st November 2011

Coming into force - - 8th November 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, near Lutterworth, in the Counties of Leicestershire and Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Cross in Hand Roundabout, Lutterworth) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 8th November 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the roundabout" means the circulatory carriageway of the A5 at its junction

with A4303 Coventry Road, B4027 Lutterworth Road and

Coal Pit Lane, known as Cross in Hand Roundabout;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 15th

November 2011 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the southern sector of the roundabout.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- **5.** The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle
 - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - (c) being used in connection with the said works.
