**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A34 Trunk Road (Winnall) (Closure of Lay-bys) Order  
2011**

*Made* - - - - *7th November 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - *9th January 2012*

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A34 Trunk Road (Winnall) (Closure of Lay-bys) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 9th January 2012.

2. In this Order:-

“the trunk road” means the A34 Trunk Road at Winnall near Winchester in the County of Hampshire; and

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b).

3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the lay-by in the southbound carriageway of the trunk road or the lay-by in the northbound carriageway of the trunk road opposite the Wykeham Industrial Estate near the M3 at Junction 9.
