## ROAD TRAFFIC

The A46 Trunk Road (Newark-on-Trent to Lincoln) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

> Made 25th October 2011 Coming into force -1st November 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road ("the A46") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads, between Newark-on-Trent in the County of Nottinghamshire and Lincoln in the County of Lincolnshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Newark-on-Trent to Lincoln) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 1st November 2011.

## 2. In this Order:

"a slip road" means -

> i) the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with Brough Lane, north of

Brough;

ii) the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with Haddington Lane, north of

Haddington;

"the works period" means the period starting at 21.00 hours on Tuesday 8th

November 2011 and ending when the said works have

been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
  - **5.** The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-
    - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
    - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
    - (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
