## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The M6 Motorway (Junction 9) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made 31st October 2011 Coming into force - -7th November 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway ("the M6") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that motorway and four of those connecting roads, at Junction 9 in the Metropolitan Borough of Walsall, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junction 9) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 7th November 2011.

## 2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means -

> i) the northbound carriageway of the M6 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A461 at Junction 9 to its junction with the entry slip road leading from that roundabout;

ii) the southbound carriageway of the M6 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A461 at Junction 9 to its junction with the entry

slip road leading from that roundabout;

"a slip road" means any slip road leading to or from the M6 at Junction

"the works period" means the period starting at 22.00 hours on Saturday 12th

November 2011 and ending when the said works have

been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or a slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
  - 5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-
    - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
    - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform, or
    - (iii) being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
