ROAD TRAFFIC

The A34 Trunk Road (Marcham Interchange, Southbound Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made--14th November 2011Coming into force-3rd December 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A34 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A34 Trunk Road (Marcham Interchange, Southbound Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 3rd December 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A34 Trunk Road near Abingdon in the County of Oxfordshire;

"the length of southbound carriageway" means the southbound carriageway of the trunk road between the slip road leading to the A415 at Marcham Interchange and the slip road leading from the A415 at that Interchange;

"works" mean essential carriageway repairs and all associated work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 5th December 2011 or on any subsequent day until 2nd June 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of southbound carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
