ROAD TRAFFIC

The A168 Trunk Road (Dishforth Interchange) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011

Made - - - - 22nd November 2011

Coming into force - - 4th December 2011

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A168 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of Harrogate, in the County of North Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road and some of those connecting roads should be restricted because lighting renewal works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A168 Trunk Road (Dishforth Interchange) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 4th December 2011.
2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 5th December 2011 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the A168 Trunk Road link road connecting, and including, all the roundabout at Dishforth Interchange, a distance of 560 metres.
3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
