ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1 Trunk Road (Chesterton, Cambridgeshire) Northbound Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made---28th November 2011Coming into force--5th December 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road ("the A1") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Chesterton, Cambridgeshire) Northbound Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 5th December 2011.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 6 ½ hours starting at 09:30 hours on Tuesday 6th December 2011, or on any subsequent day until resurfacing works being carried out on an adjacent County road by the local authority have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A1 northbound entry slip road from or exit slip road to the C336 Oundle Road, Chesterton.

3. The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.
